3. Speaker

As an early career researcher at the age of 31, Dr. Dr. Kerem Böge has already traveled far in his career. He focuses on the development of clinical psychology and psychiatry, as a clinical psychologist, researcher and lecturer, at Charité - Universitätsmedizin Berlin. His fields of research include the development of novel psychotherapeutic approaches, their process and outcome for schizophrenia spectrum- as well as affective disorders, refugee populations and chronic pain patients. His expertise also includes population-based questions, qualitative data collection, mixed-methods approaches or multi-center randomized controlled trials. During his presentation he will outline his work in global mental health and stigma research, primarily in low- and middle income countries.
