Within a given scenario, we simulate a cross-sectoral, multi-stakeholder dialogue and inspire holistic and systemic thinking on the global health challenges of Neglected Tropical Diseases (NTDs). Success will require a context-adapted research agenda setting as well as cooperation among the diverse stakeholders – ranging from researchers to local communities, non-governmental organizations, political and funding agents.
