



GLOHRA Training Certificate - Aligned with doctoral programs

1. Description

The Global Health Academy is an initiative of the German Alliance for Global Health Research (GLOHRA) to support the next generation of global health researchers. The GLOHRA Training Certificate is an offer for doctoral students and postdocs from all disciplines who wish to have a certificate for training to prove the research skills gained via GLOHRA.

Early career researchers can register for the:

- **Standard Training Certificate** (30 hours*): for GLOHRA and non-GLOHRA members, or
- **Advanced Training Certificate** (60 hours*): GLOHRA members only

* 30 hours equals 1 ECTS-CP

The Global Health Academy cooperates with existing doctoral programs at German Universities who recognize the credits collected for the GLOHRA Training Certificate as proof of achievement (Leistungsnachweis). These programs are listed [here](#).

For other doctoral programs, please note that the awarding of ECTS-CP on the GLOHRA Training Certificate does not automatically imply that the ECTS-CP will be recognized by your Thesis Advisory Committee/Doctoral Office.

2. How do I get the GLOHRA Training Certificate?

1. Register for the GLOHRA Training Certificate

Please register by sending the application form to the [Academy Coordinator](#) (starting in January 2023). Your participation in GLOHRA events will count towards the GLOHRA Training Certificate **only after your registration**. After registration, trainees have a maximum of three years to collect the necessary credits.

2. Identify and attend eligible GLOHRA events

Eligible GLOHRA events are announced on the Website, in the GLOHRA Newsletter and through the GLOHRA [LinkedIn](#) channels. Please make sure you register for the events as required.

3. Collect your Certificate

Once you have accumulated the credits required for either the standard or advanced course, you can submit a list with all the credit-earning activities you participated in to the Academy Coordinator. This will be cross-checked against our participation lists. After verification, you will receive the GLOHRA Training Certificate that states the credits (in hours) and trainings you attended. If your doctoral program recognizes the GLOHRA Training Certificate, submit it to your faculty office/doctoral program.
