2. Catalogue of Competencies

The Catalogue of Competencies presents a framework for competencies in global health research at doctoral and postdoctoral levels that considers diverse disciplines and progressive development of different competency levels. It centers discipline-specific research knowledge, skills, and attitudes of individual researchers (Domain 0), and the integration of global perspectives for research (Domain 7), while addressing essential competencies for all researchers (Domains 1-6) that are specifically adapted for work in the field of global health.



Within the Global Health Academy, the Catalogue will be used to identify gaps in the research training landscape and develop training offers to fill these gaps. Beyond GLOHRA, the **Catalogue invites individuals and institutions to reflect on integrating further competencies in training and career development for global health research** (e.g. develop curricula; design evaluation criteria; facilitate interdisciplinary dialogue and collaboration; and promote research, education and funding in the field of global health).
