What is it about?

In Germany, research and access to safe abortion care are shaped by stigma and barriers. Through international networking and exchange, we aim to build on the gaps identified in upto-date studies and work towards improving and expanding scientific access to this field.

What is our goal?

By using Story Circles and Patient Journey Mapping, we aim to exchange experiences, refine research objectives and identify the resulting challenges.

What are the requirements for participation?

We are reaching out to researchers interested in the topic of abortion care — whether already engaged in this field through their current work or looking to focus on it in the future. We value a broad spectrum of experiences and perspectives in order to foster interdisciplinary exchange, shed light on the topic from multiple angles, and identify existing research gaps. Our aim is to bring together a diverse group of participants with different areas of expertise, professional backgrounds, and levels of experience.

Participation in the workshop is free of charge. The primary language of the workshop will be German. The application deadline is October 5, 2025.
